Dear Democratic Committee member:

Four years ago, I ran for Pittsford Town Justice to bring my experience and our shared values to the judicial system. With the support of the Democratic Committee—we made some history—I became the first Democrat elected to the office, receiving a record-breaking number of votes. Now, with Judge Vacca's promotion to the Federal District Court, there is a vacancy in our County Court that will need to be filled quickly for this November's ballot. **When the Monroe County Democratic Committee convenes in the coming weeks, I am asking for your support to be the Democratic nominee for County Court Judge.**

For nearly the last five years, I have served as the Principal Law Clerk in Monroe County Court. **As Judge Dollinger's right hand, we have led the way by handling more felony-level cases than any other superior criminal court in Monroe County.** We have done this by acting not just as 'umpires calling balls and strikes,' but also by utilizing our diversion treatment courts, where compassion meets accountability, to be problem-solvers. Programs, such as the Judicial Diversion Program and Veterans Court, reduce recidivism, save lives, and make our community stronger.

As Pittsford Town Justice, I have presided over thousands of cases, both criminal and civil, along with landlord-tenant matters - just as we do in County Court. My knowledge of the law and community-based resources have allowed me to get at-risk individuals into treatment faster and has made me the judge that many of my colleagues turn to for advice. **My leadership has been recognized by my election as Vice President of the Monroe County Magistrate's Association.** My experience and knowledge of the administration of justice has prepared me to serve as a County Court Judge.

As a defense trial lawyer, I was involved in cases ranging from low-level offenses to murder cases in courts across our county and state, including through the Assigned Counsel Program for individuals unable to afford an attorney. I frequently utilized the problem-solving diversion courts to get my clients help with the underlying problems that allowed them to avoid being permanently labeled with criminal records. As a civil attorney, I represented small businesses here in our community to help them create jobs and grow our economy, and individuals as they bought their first home, planned for the future, or, in their times of need, fought for civil justice.

**Simply put, I will be ready to serve our community on day one.**

Prior to joining the judiciary, I volunteered in smaller ways on campaigns, such as making phone calls in 2008 and 2012. However, since 2016, I felt compelled to do more, so I got involved in local campaigns, knocked doors alongside many of you, managed a county-wide campaign in 2019 during which I met even more of you, and ultimately put myself forward as a candidate. Together, we've transformed the judiciary across Monroe County—for the better. I am proud of the work that

I put in while part of this Committee, and I will run a campaign worthy of your endorsement. **I have the necessary experience running successful local and county-wide campaigns to work collaboratively, as we did in 2019 and 2020, to be part of the slate this year.**

As a judge, every decision that I make aims to fairly apply our laws, live up to our values, and advance the motto '*Justice for All*'. It is an honor and privilege to serve our community from the bench, and with your support, I hope to continue serving our greater community in this larger role. **I humbly ask for your vote in the upcoming committee election for County Court.** I hope that we can work together to continue the momentum of our movement for a brighter future for Monroe County.
